ESIA HEARS FROM SACRAMENTO PD

The Sacramento Police Department East Command Executive Lieutenant Marnie Stigerts attended our board meeting on Monday, August 10th. She stated that overall property crime has gone down in our neighborhood, likely due to more people at home during the COVID pandemic and with neighbors telecommuting from home. She talked about the homelessness in our neighborhood. Because of COVID restrictions, the Sacramento Police Department is not able to break up the homeless camps in the City, including ones in our neighborhood at 29th / C Street and 30th/ J Street. We understand the City is working on these issues city-wide. ESIA brought to her attention the increase in speeding cars throughout our neighborhood and close calls with pedestrians. She told our Board that she will follow up with the patrol unit and see if they can decrease the speeding cars. Lieutenant Stigerts provided us with the contact information for Lt. EAST SAC WELCOME GARDEN VOLUNTEER(S) NEEDED

ESIA is seeking a volunteer or volunteers to help maintain the small garden area surrounding the Welcome to East Sacramento sign located at the corner of H Street and Alhambra Boulevard. The plot is City-owned, but it needs a little extra TLC to look its best. Estimated time to maintain the Welcome to East Sacramento garden is one hour per week, perhaps a bit more in the Spring and Fall. Volunteer responsibilities would include:

- Trimming the small bushes
- Deadheading and pruning the rose bushes
- Weeding
- Removing any trash
- Removing dead plants, if necessary and replacing with new plants, as needed
- Watering as needed, and alerting City Parks if there is a problem (broken sprinkler, no water, etc.)
